## School Support for

## Children with histories of Early Trauma

## including Adopted & Children Looked After

Children who have suffered trauma in their early lives can present as having social, emotional and behavioural difficulties at school. Their learning and their way of relating to teachers and peers is often affected too. This training can help staff teams in schools to understand and support these children!

### **Short course: 1.5 to 2 hours (with possibility of follow-up)**

This is an initial awareness-raising module which introduces staff to new ways of understanding these children, as well to some new ways of supporting them.

### **Long course: 4 to 5 hours**

This will be a more in-depth training enabling a more thorough understanding of these children's difficulties and how to help them: regulate their emotions and behaviours; establish and maintain more appropriate relationships with peers and adults; access the curriculum more successfully.
